HyperSol 888 NXT, which *Master Fluid Solutions* is showcasing at IMTS 2022 in Chicago, lets machine shops operate more efficiently by maximizing the capabilities of the equipment they already have on hand.

"Cutting fluid makes up less than half a percent of the cost of a part, but a small difference in a price in a coolant can have a huge difference in the total effect of what a part costs," says John Treese, the company's director of global training.

Meanwhile, measurement and quality-control tools, such as MeasurLink from *Mitutoyo*, curb the time required for quality control.

MeasurLink puts data from inspection tools into a centralized location where engineers and production and quality managers can analyze it "and effectively come up with cost reductions, continuous improvement, increased throughput and increased productivity and really make their customers happy," says Hany Abdel-Motaleb, national data management and MeasurLink sales engineer for Mitutoyo.
