- With the introduction of its Double Quattromill 22 at IMTS 2018, SECO Tools dispensed with traditional nickel coating on the new cutter line and reduced its environmental impact. SECO also has begun to polish its popular Performax drill rather than apply a Teflon nickel coating, making the drill more fatigue-resistant

The latest cutter line introduced by SECO Tools, the Double Quattromill 22, and an upgraded version of its Performax drill do away with coatings. The result? These tools are eco-friendly.

“We’re trying to reduce our environmental impact,” says the company’s Tim Aydt, product manager of indexable milling.
